

Corporate Flight Management to Co-Host a US Conference regarding General Aviation Trends in the Peoples Republic of China

"China is on the verge of major growth in the General Aviation sector as government policies open up more of the airspace for use by business and private aircraft ", said CFM CEO Allen Howell.

"Recently, Chinese officials acknowledged the only 1,000 GA aircraft operate in their nation today. They project that number to increase to 100,000. By comparison, there are 200,000 GA aircraft currently operating in the US," Howell said.

As part of this growth trend Mike Vaughn, CFM Director of Government and International Sales, recently facilitated the sale of 60 general aviation aircraft in China to be used for primary and advanced flight training.
